Tonight, Tina addressed us , beginning her talk with a practical demonstration on how easy it is to make a loaf of bread. She shared the ingredients but not the quantities with us. This is to be found in her book, “Plated” which was on sale after the meeting. She has always loved cooking and entertaining others, be it around the kitchen table, at dinner parties, or catering for many weddings and corporate events as former owner of White Tie Catering in Christchurch.

She shared her interesting history with us. Her passion for cooking started while helping her mother cook on the Weedons farm she grew up on and her love affair with food continued when she went to London where she met her husband. She then returned to New Zealand and the family settled on a farm in Fairlie. After selling the farm , she spent 12 months in France. Returning once again to New Zealand with her husband and 4 daughters. She entered into and eventually bought the White Tie catering business here in Christchurch. After a very successful period, she sold the business to her daughter and in turn to a prominent Christchurch hospitality figure, Johnny Schwartz.

Tina wrote her book, “Plated” with recipes learned from her mother, her subsequent time in London, France and New Zealand and her time at White Tie Catering. In the book she shares her favourite recipes together with time-saving tips and links to video instructions She emphasizes how to prepare, cook and present your food for maximum effect and minimal stress, ensuring you spend less time in the kitchen and more time around the table with guests.
