# # 33 for 12 March 2025

Our speaker tonight was our very own vibrant club member, Sara Mackenzie, whose topic was *Our Collaboration & Achievements with Bali Rotary – International Committee*. Sara had been to Bali a couple of times and was dismayed at the lack of clean fresh water in homes in the outer villages, where water is scarce and some villagers live with poor sanitation, schools and health facilities.

However, projects are in place to start to rectify this and our club, via the International Committee, has donated \$1000 towards the purchase of reticulation pipes to link together and deliver water from government built, reinforced concrete reservoirs ["tanks"] nestled in the mountains above a village. "Tanks", because they are not large. Linked together there are 4 of them. This particular project will help provide fresh, clean water to 75 family homes. Eventually, the finished system will be handed over to village control.

Sara stressed that these high country villages are very poor and do not get the tourist 'dollar', the conditions of villages making for limited numbers of visitors.



Further on water, Rotary Bali Action are providing families with water filters at \$35 per unit, each household. The units have a life span of 3 years.

Bali Sehat is a humanitarian organisation, working with Rotary Club of Bali Action in helping Bali's poor to access health service and education - also supported by Rotary Clubs Alfredton and Hope Island. To that end, our club's International Committee had donated \$1000 towards the purchase of a centrifuge for medical purposes.

Interestingly, Sara and the 'floor' rated \$NZ1000 at approximately 3000 Rupiahs. Inflation has taken over somewhere, as Google gives: \$1.000 NZD = Rp9,396 IDR. What that means to our charitable intentions is beyond this writer's imagination.

Thank you Sara. Your direction towards this project and your presentation tonight, are greatly appreciated.


