Speaker Report 24 September 2025 – N.B. no guest speakers last club meetings each month. Club Forum instead.

Summary of Club Forum:

Youth Service:

- One activity completed: \$250 to Immune Deficiency Foundation of NZ (IDFNZ) Kids Trust.
- Two ativities in the pipeline:
 - 1. Boyle River Outdoor Education Centre Young Leaders Programme : two Year 11 Cashmere high students on a week long leadership cours (2 x \$930 + \$1860).

- 2. Rotary NZ Science and technology Forum (Auckland University, live in), 10 to 24 January. 1 x year 12 student, Cashmere High, 1 x 1,500 [plus parent contribution, 995] = 2495.
- Consideration for one Rotary Youth Leadership Award (RYLA) attendee at leadership course, College House, University of Canterbury @ \$1,175 (GST exempt). 18 to 22 Jan. 2026.
- Consideration for our Rotary District designated, lower decile Waltham School, to receive assistance from J R McKenzie Youth Education Fund. The Fund wishes to help where death, sickness, family break-up or economic hardship cause difficulty for young people and their caregivers to meet the costs of their education.

Vocational Service:

- Seeking a Young Totara nomination from Cashmere High School.
- Worksite visits: Rainui House (next Wed).

Parakiore Recreation and Sports Centre, One NZ Stadium, Tauranga Library and Orana Park , hydroponic lettuce farm are other possibilities.

Community Service:

- Consideration for donation \$250 to Wandersearch and to renovation of the new Citizens Advice Bureau.
- Support of upcoming repeat payments to Orana Park and Pohatu penguins.
- Emphasis that it was not just \$'s but also volunteer hours donated to the community by the club viz. street appeals coming up (Pink Ribbon @ ChCh airport and Dementia @ New World, St Martins). The club also devotes a large number of volunteer hours at Cashmere Stream Esplanade (8 Nov) and John Taylor Walkway.

International Service:

Three potential projects in the pipeline:

- 1.Rotary Club of Rarotonga regarding potential collaboration on an existing Cook Island Public Health Project. The budget and details will be discussed with the club when they are available.
- 2. Ramesh Rao of Bangalore RC who visited our club last year, ha emailed regarding collaboration in the Sanjeevanni Heart Care Global Grant Project. We are seeking clarification on what is expected of our club.
- 3. DGE Sandra Isaacs has appealed to Presidents of Christchurch Rotary Clubs for financial support towards Riccarton and Apia Rotary supplying solar power to the Campus of Hope in Samoa. Our potential involvement will be discussed at club level once further details are provided.
