Alli too, founder 2 years ago, of family board game, Sharenanigans, during her time at university and working among students as a business workshop facilitator.



Sharenanigans: The Board Game Empowering Future Investors

Many people are not introduced to the concept of investing in shares until later in life and by then they've lost valuable time to make potential gains and there is the chance that some perceived barriers have already formed about who you have to be and what it takes to invest. There are of course, a range of accessible ways to learn how to invest, what's missing are conversations around the topic in households and classrooms at a younger age.



Built initially on the concept of Monopoly, Sharenanigans is a fun and competitive board game based on the key principles of how to invest in shares! A subconscious learning in game form, it involves 4 different industries and was a year in the making, before being launched last year.

Funding for the enterprise involved PledgeMe (New Zealand's Crowdfunding Platform) to a closure at \$48k from 348 pledgers in just 4 weeks. Based on pre-ordering, money doesn't leave the account if not a runner.

The launch involved a big marketing push – 7Sharp interview, One News, The Press, Radio NZ ... and a trip to Shanghai to ensure timely delivery. There were 3,000 views on Tic Toc The game was first promoted at the Warehouse stores. Three thousand games showed up in 9 pallets and stored in the home garage. Now several significant retail stores are supporting this young girl.

Alli's favourite review is by a 10 year old grl: "Best game I've ever played"

Alli pointed up Sylvia Bloom, a 96 year old American legal secretary who by copying her bosses' investment decisions, secretly accumulated a significant fortune and donated the bulk of it—US\$8.2 million—for scholarships for underprivileged students upon her death.

Alli's enterprise is now involved in developing Flip Table games, one this year, 4 for next year, which involve flipping cards, pressing one's luck, or strategic card play.

Best of luck Alli. Go for it!
