Discussion:

Delegated Financial Authority for Committees (Up to \$500)

To consider adopting a streamlined process whereby Club committees are granted delegated spending authority of up to \$500 per item, removing the current requirement for full Trust Board approval for minor expenditures. It is proposed that the Trust Chair be authorised to approve such expenditures at their discretion up to \$500, with appropriate reporting to the Trust Board to ensure transparency and accountability. This change aims to improve efficiency and responsiveness while maintaining sound governance. It is acknowledged that a minor constitutional amendment may be required to implement this proposal.
